Commencing at 8:00PM from the Camdenton High School, the **Summer Night Stride 5K Run/Walk** begins with a loop around the high school & practice field; proceeds onto Laker Pride Drive; veers off by the soccer field and then continues down Laker Pride Drive for an out & back; then a second loop around the school & field; finishing in front of the school. This is a moderate 3.1 mile course. Walkers will be positioned behind the running competitors at the race start. Dogs on leashes are welcome.
